

Village Print Shop

The print shop was built to resemble a “typical small business of the early 1900’s”. The dismantling of old buildings provided the lumber used in its construction. On display is an impressive array of printing equipment that was donated to the museum by Vopni Press of Portage la Prairie. The shop provides a vintage setting for the equipment and has been set up as a newspaper office.

Some of the artifacts displayed are various printing presses, old typewriters and adding machines, a Gestetner machine, linotype, and old style photocopier, a foot powered stapler, and several paper presses.
