

Doctor/Dentist/Lawyer Offices

This building was moved to the museum in 1991 from the Martin farm in Oakville District with funding from the Manitoba Heritage Foundation and the Ladies Auxillary. The building houses a doctor's office, complete with waiting room; dentist's office; and a lawyer's office.

The Portage General Hospital donated much of the medical equipment on display in the waiting room. The doctor's office contains a doctor's bag, medicine bottle, old equipment, lots of medical books, bedpans, glass hot water bottle, and an instrument sterilizer. Other artifacts include old surgical and dental tools, needles, crutches and a wheelchair. One room is Dr. Dalziel's dentist office with typical old equipment including an electric oven for preparing gold work for teeth and a foot powered dental drill..... open wide!

A side room contains a lawyer's office with furniture and artifacts from several former law offices in Portage la Prairie.
